This involves me editing the final draft of the script and being in charge of editorial changes to the script throughout the rehearsal, as well as operating the autocue for the rehearsal and live show.

BBC EUROPEAN CHAMPS 2022- SCRIPT EDITOR- 20/08/2022-21/08/2022

This involved me keeping track of the producers editorial changes and making sure they were up to date within the autocue script throughout the live coverage of the event.

BBC COMMONWEALTH GAMES 2022-SCRIPT EDITOR -29/07/2022-2/08/2022

This involved me keeping track of the producers editorial changes and making sure they were up to date within the autocue script throughout the live coverage of the event.

SKY NEWS- OUTPUT PRODUCER-17/04/2022-19/04/2022

This particular role involved editing and researching content for the Kay Burley and Breakfast show. For example, editing SOTS, writing cues, finding stills and creating graphics for stories.
